The facility where we stayed was more than adequate with rooms for us to sleep in, a gathering room for meetings and meals, and a kitchen to prepare all our meals. Raham Baptist Church and Pastor Javier Reyes were gracious hosts who opened their hearts to us and kept us encouraged. The weather was hot but the Lord provided strength and courage to work on to completion. And the Lord used us to declare the good news of Jesus Christ with Olga, her family, and neighbors.

Through our work and witness, the Lord Jesus was lifted up and the message of salvation was heard! Once again, we put into action the great work of missions that we have supported through our giving and taught to our people year after year.

I am convinced that, though we are back from Guayama, the mission trip is not over. The Lord Jesus has opened a door for us and I am not ready to close it. I don't know when and where the Lord will move us to go next, but we have been mobilized and moved from our home place here in Oak Ridge. Let us be ready to go out into the world and make disciples. That is the Great Commission and that is at the heart of who we are as Christ followers. Join me in praying that we will be ready to go and play our part as workers in the harvest fields.

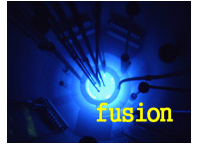
