

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY TEAM

Your newest Bereavement Ministry Team has been in place since January 2017 and we have discovered several things: 1) you continue to be a loving and giving church; 2) we need more volunteers to provide food and/or serve and cleanup; and 3) we need funds for the meats for the meals. Up until recently, the Adult 6 Men have been providing chicken for the funerals for which we are very appreciative. However, they are not able to continue. Chicken strips cost about \$65 for a medium platter which covers 20-25 people. If you add a small ham, that is about \$10 more. Therefore, we would like to have one or two special offerings during the year to be taken during the Lord's Supper to use for our church family's funeral meals.
