Church family,

August 2, 2009 was the first Sunday the Scott family worshiped together with the Robertsville family. It was a joyous occasion that morning filled with excitement and anticipation of how the Lord would lead and work in the years ahead. Now that we've been on the journey together for ten years, I can look back and see how full it has been—full of life, love, growth, prayer, worship, missions, vision. The Spirit of the Lord has abided with us and drawn us closer to Jesus and one another in sweet fellowship. Ten years ago I was proud to call South Georgia home. Today, I am proud to call East Tennessee home, to know Robertsville Baptist Church, not the building or the address but the people, as my family, my people. It's the blessing of the Lord to create that kind of deep connection between kindred spirits. I thank the Lord for the privilege and honor of working and serving alongside so many faithful and Jesus-loving folks.

Another exciting development is the beginning of Home Groups. This is a new way for us to gather on Sunday nights in homes to fellowship around the table, growing together in our love for Jesus through conversation, prayer, learning, and being strengthened for our Christian life in the week ahead. Beginning August 18 until October 20 (no meeting on Sept. 1 or Oct. 6), the first season of Home Groups will meet in various homes across town. They will meet from 5:30 to 7:30 pm. This first season will feature *The Quest*, a 6-session study by Beth Moore. Home Groups are not a new program or strategy. It grows out of a desire to experience the Holy Spirit in the same way the first group of Jesus followers did in the book of Acts. The aim is for Home Groups to be characterized by the following realities:

- Simple - a simple structure that gives the Holy Spirit space to work
- Authentic - person-to-person relating that allows the Holy Spirit to create *koinonia* ("fellowship" in Acts 2:42)
- Organic - meeting home to home where the Holy Spirit makes each *oikos* ("house" in Acts 2:46) to be a place of hospitality and peace
- Peaceable - compliments the current life of the church

I'm confident the Lord will work in a new way, person to person and home to home. I'm confident the Lord will add to His church, for it's the Lord who gives the increase. And I'm confident the Lord will continue to build Robertsville to be a flourishing branch of Christ's church.

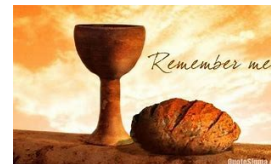
