### **CONGRATULATIONS**

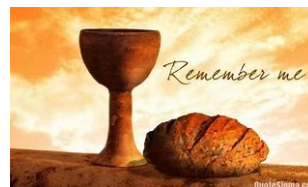

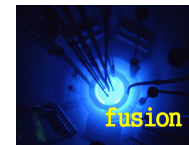
