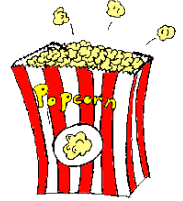

PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH

As the weather cools off, it's easy to tell the season is changing. Seasons come and go. This is true of our personal lives as well. Times of activity and industriousness are exchanged for periods of rest and reflection. In our spiritual lives, action in ministry and service are usually followed by periods of quiet and stillness. Which of the two is more in line with God's will or direction? Does God lead us to action or to stillness? Can the Spirit of the Lord be found in both? Yes and yes. Jesus is a model for this: intense times of teaching and healing and then periods of pulling away. Where are you? In a season of action or stillness? Don't have the misconception that one is more spiritual than the other. For, God can bring about great growth in both. If you are in an action mode, work with faithfulness and diligence, and God will grow you up in Christ. If you are in a still mode, stand or sit with mindfulness of God's word, God's ways, and God's will, and God will grow you deeper in Christ. And just like the browning of fall and the coldness of winter will give in to the budding of spring and the heat of summer, stillness will be reactivated; likewise, action will be quieted. Hold on to both. Ps. 46:10 says, "Be still and know that I am God" and 1 Cor. 10:31 says, "So whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."

Medical supplies have been moved to Room 316. Walkers, wheelchairs, portable toilet chairs and many other items are available. You may check items out through the church office.

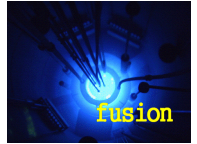
