When we meet on Sunday, May 24, be aware of some guidelines and changes that are in place for being together.

Guidelines

- Maintain 6 feet between one another for social distancing. Thanks for not shaking hands or hugging. Feel free to use all the waves, smiles, or hollers you want.
- Though masks are optional, they will help to minimize the potential for spread. Masks are available in the foyer.
- Wash hands often and use sanitizer. Hand sanitizer is located in the foyer.
- Please make your way into the sanctuary upon arriving. We ask that the foyer not be used for visiting or sitting.
- Restrooms will be limited to one person at a time. When you leave the restroom, please turn off the light to indicate vacancy to others.
- The drive-through doors will remain closed, except for rain. Please enter through the main foyer or side doors of the sanctuary.
- Be mindful of preparing for worship by 10:40 am. That is when our live broadcast begins. If you enter the sanctuary after 10:40 am, please be as quiet as possible.

Changes

- Offering plates will be located at doors and will not be passed during the service. Mailing in offerings and online giving continue to be great ways to give.
- Sanctuary side doors, as well as the main foyer, will be open for entry/exit.
- The facility—including the office, fellowship hall/kitchen, and classrooms—remains closed with the exception of the main foyer and sanctuary.
- Groups/ministries such as Sunday School classes, choir, childcare, and library will not be meeting on campus.
- The back and side sections and the main aisle of the sanctuary are sectioned off. Seating in the front is open. Use the side aisles as you find your seat.
- A temporary setup is in place for the live video feed. The camera will be permanently installed in the near future.

We are excited about being back together on May 24! We know these are uncharted waters filled with unknowns but also with the new things the Lord is doing. Hang on to His word from 1 Peter 5:10, "And the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will Himself restore you and make you strong, firm, and steadfast."
