Wednesday night programming resumes on August 12 at 6pm.

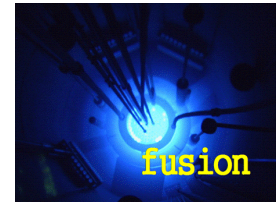
Kids City (birth—2nd grade)

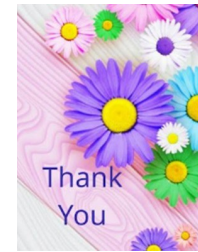
A WORD FROM JACK
